



# 2018 Fees

## ANNUAL TUITION FEE - \$NZ 15,000

Includes ESOL Tuition and curriculum text books on loan. This is required in advance for a full year's study. Does not include TOEFL, IELTS, or NZQA examination entry fees.

Juniors - \$3750 per term

Seniors - \$4250 per term for terms 1,2,3 and \$2250 for term 4

## CONTINGENCY FUND - \$NZ 2,000

This is an estimated amount required to cover uniform, stationery and other expenses, including outdoor education excursion fees, school trips, sports affiliation fees etc. It is held on account for the student and any unused balance, if any, is refunded when the student completes their schooling at Cambridge High School.

Please note: This contingency fund is not for pocket money and no students will be issued with funds from this account as it is to be used only for school based expenses.

## INSURANCE 1 YEAR - APPROX \$NZ 750

Travel / medical / property insurance is a condition of enrolment. This can be arranged by the school with Uni-care which includes assisting students with their claims and other policy matters. ## HOMESTAY - \$NZ 240 PER WEEK

Our quality homestay programme is administered by the school. Payment is required in advance. To satisfy student visa requirements, a student's homestay account should always be in credit of one term's homestay. Homestays provide a furnished room per student, three meals per day, laundry, plus care

and guidance, and is organised by the Homestay Co-ordinator who maintains regular contact with the homestays, students and student's family as well as assisting with the student's out of school needs.

Please note: A two week homestay termination fee may apply in some circumstances.

Full homestay fees will apply during term breaks, except during the Christmas/New Year period if the student returns home.

## PLACEMENT AND SUPERVISION FEE \$NZ 250

This provides ongoing contact and supervision of the student and the homestay by the Homestay Co-ordinator, advice and guidance, administration of student visa renewal, assistance with medical, dental, and banking needs.

All fees are quoted in New Zealand dollars and include Goods and Services Tax ("GST") where applicable. The normal rate is 15%. This is a New Zealand government tax payable on the supply of goods and services. If the GST rate increases, we reserve the right to change our fees accordingly.

## SHORT-TERM STAYS

Ask about the short term study stay options available at our school. Cost per week of tuition is \$400.00 plus homestay and placement fees and insurance. Students are able to wear their school uniform from their home country. We also have some Cambridge High School uniform available for students to borrow.
